Colour:	Deep purple-red
Nose:	Dark cherry and chocolate aromas are matched by subtle spicy oak.
Palate:	A very complex palate with chocolate, red berries flavours and fine-grained tannins
Style:	Matured for 12 months in 50% French and 50% American oak barriques
Complement:	Red meat, smoked meat, gamey meat and strong cheeses
Best drinking:	Now to 2015
Closure:	Screw cap
